SECURITY

The European Parliament has airport-style security screening.
Please bring a valid passport or national identity card.
Large luggage should be avoided whenever possible.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Brussels Airport (BRU)

- Train to **Bruxelles-Luxembourg / Brussel-Luxemburg Station**
- Journey time: approximately **30–35 minutes**

Alternatively:

- Taxi: approximately **25–35 minutes** depending on traffic.

From Brussels Midi (South) Railway Station

- Metro lines 2 or 6 to **Trône/Troon**, then a short walk
- Taxi: approximately **15 minutes**

Public transport

Nearest stations:

- **Bruxelles-Luxembourg / Brussel-Luxemburg** (railway station)
- **Trône / Troon** (Metro lines 2 & 6)
- Several STIB/MIVB bus routes serve the European Quarter.

The following hotels are conveniently located in Brussels and offer easy access to the European Parliament by public transport, taxi or on foot. The indicative room rates are generally within the **€120–200+ per night** range (subject to availability and booking dates).
